B.Y.O.D. ACCEPTABLE DEVICES

Please review the guidelines below to make sure your educational device complies with our B.Y.O.D. requirements:

The school will provide a minimal number of charging stations in designated areas throughout the school. Students will also need to bring charging cables to make use of the stations.
