



**Holy Cross High School Graduation 2017**



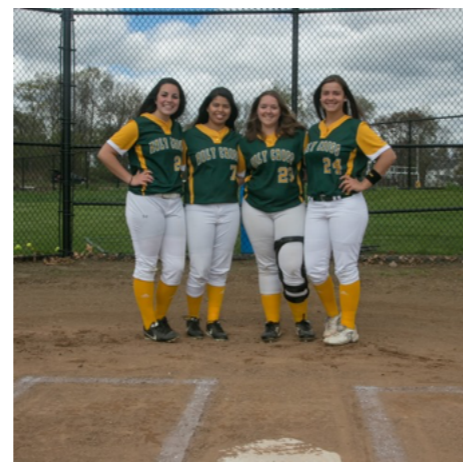

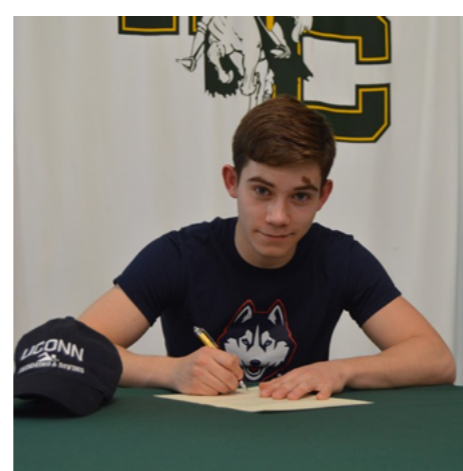
